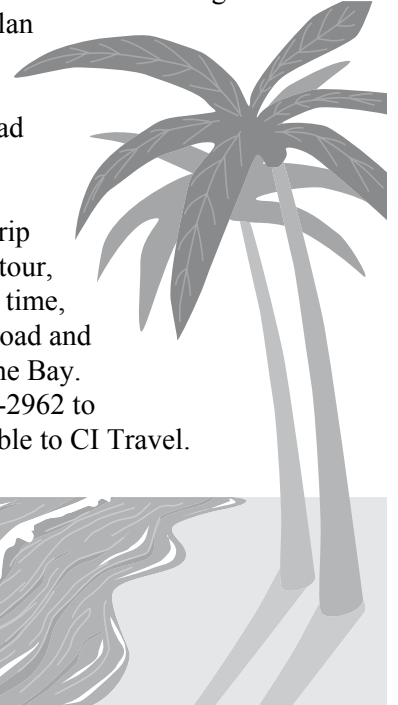
BUS TRIPS

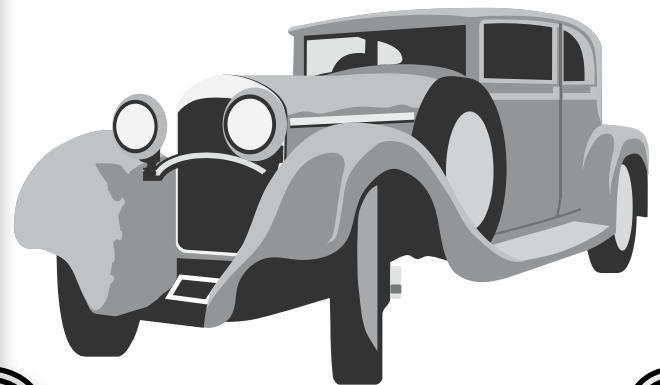


Canoe/Kayak on the Peace River Arcadia, FL

Refuse Can(s) and Personal Property

Refuse Can(s) may be placed curbside no earlier than 6:00 p.m. the night before scheduled trash pick up and must be removed and secured from view within the garage by no later than 6:00 p.m. the day of trash pick up.

Be courteous of your neighboring homes and do not allow items to accumulate in the driveway, entryways or walkway areas. Tidy the front of your home by screening or removing any garden hoses, toys or working materials. None of these items are to be on the property that is visible from other homes or common area.

Lease Notification

Leasing Out Your Home – It is a requirement of the Governing Documents (Article XIX- Conveyances Sections 19.1, 19.2) that Unit Owners notify the Association in writing of any changes in occupancy not less than 20 days prior to the effective date of any lease. Resident Bar Code Notification

If you do not have a Valid Bar Code corresponding to home ownership, are not an authorized tenant with a current lease on file with Southwest Property Mgt., or do not have a current lease renewal on file with the Town Manager's Office, your bar code will be turned off.
