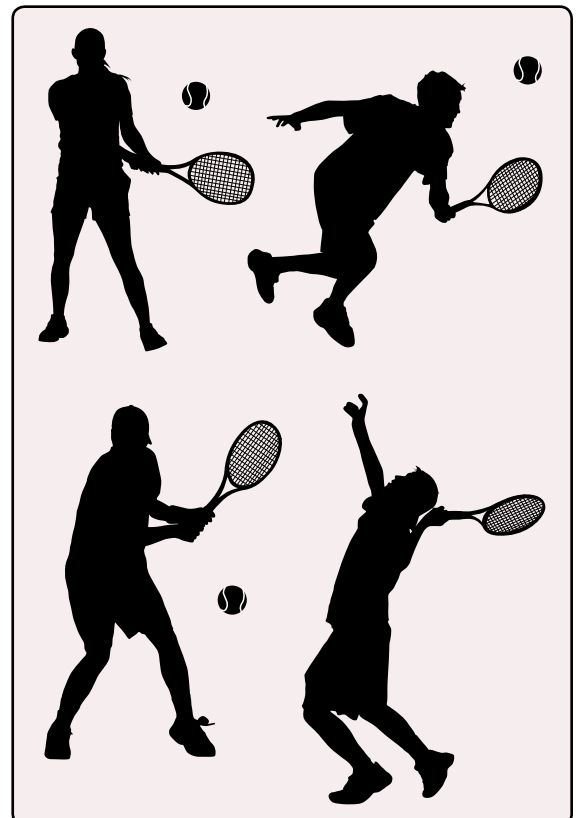

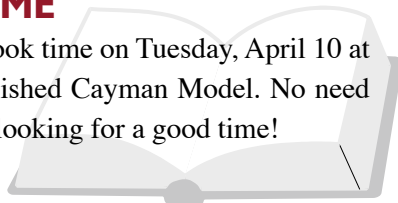

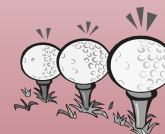

Update the HOA office with your mailing information (call Cheryl 261-3440 ext. 23) and emergency contact information i.e. your home watch provider (call 774-0026). Have someone periodically check your home for weeds in the driveway, and/or any periodical maintenance that should be performed on the exterior.

PETS. PLEASE BE AWARE COUNTY COLLIER COUNTY LAWS STATE THAT...

All Dogs and Cats Must Be Licensed with the County and vaccinated for rabies by the age of three months. Florida recently adopted a new law allowing for pets to be vaccinated every three years, however in order to qualify for this your pet has had to have at least one annual shot the previous year. All licenses must be attached to the collar of the animal.

Dogs and cats are NOT Allowed To Run Loose! Animals must always be confined to your property or walked on a leash! Beaches, parks, and especially School Grounds Are Off Limits. Dogs are Not Allowed To Snap, Growl, Jump On, or otherwise Threaten persons using the public right-of-ways. Dogs and cats are Not Allowed To Create A Sanitary Nuisance. Pick up after your pets. Animals are not allowed to disturb the peace and quiet of the neighborhood.

Additionally, the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions for Veronawalk states each Owner must clean up after his or her pet, no dog is to be in common areas unless under a leash and the Owner may be required to dispose of the pet if the animal becomes obnoxious to other Unit Owners.

PERSONAL PROPERTY

Be courteous of your neighboring homes and do not allow items to accumulate in the driveway, entryways or walkway areas. Basketball hoops are NOT permitted to remain in the driveway, they must be stored in the garage area unless they are in use. Additionally, tidy the front of your home by screening or removing any garden hoses, toys or working materials. None of these items are to be on the property that is visible from other homes or common area.
