Hurricane Seminar Re-Cap

On Wednesday, June 4 at 7:00 p.m. VeronaWalk hosted our first Hurricane Seminar with WINK TV and The East Naples Fire Department. Over 100 residents were in attendance for this important informational seminar. Amanda McDonald presented information regarding WINK News' radar and storm watch capabilities. WINK's ability to project a storm's path is considered by many to be the best in SW Florida. This news station should be considered a valuable informational tool during a storm situation. Greg Speers, of the East Naples Fire Control & Rescue District and Frank Barner, of the North Naples Fire District, spoke from the Fire departments viewpoint regarding Hurricanes and other emergency situations. Barry Gerenstein from the VeronaWalk Safety Committee as well as Mr. Speers and Mr. Barner, stressed the need for neighbors to help each other, and to give support in an effort to establish a Certified Emergency Response Team (C.E.R.T.) in VeronaWalk. Community Emergency Response Team

C.E.R.T.

The VeronaWalk Safety Committee urges you to participate in a C.E.R.T. Team in our community. If you're a full time VeronaWalk resident this is extremely important as we near hurricane season.

Following a major disaster, first responders who provide fire and medical services will not be able to meet the demand for these services. Factors such as number of victims, communication failures, and road blockages will prevent people from accessing emergency services they have come to expect at a moment's notice through 911. People will have to rely on each other for help in order to meet their immediate life saving and life sustaining needs.

One also expects that under these kinds of conditions, family members, fellow employees, and neighbors will spontaneously try to help each other. This was the case following the Mexico City earthquake where untrained, spontaneous volunteers saved 800 people. However, 100 people lost their lives while attempting to save others. This is a high price to pay and is preventable through training. REPORT A CRIME.

YOU CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE.

Nationwide, it was determined that the number of arrests for criminal activity would double...if only crime were reported immediately. Locally, three out of every four arrests can be related to a call from a citizen.

You, as citizens of our County, have a tremendous effect on the ability of law enforcement to successfully bring a case to conclusion. Here are some things to remember about reporting crimes.

- Report suspected criminal activity immediately...do not wait. The sooner law enforcement can respond, the more likely they are to apprehend someone.
- Be as accurate in the description of people and vehicles as you can. If they have left the area before we arrive, your observations will be the only information with which we have to work.
- If you are not sure something is wrong, report it to law enforcement anyway. It is better we check it and find nothing wrong, than allow someone to be needlessly victimized.
- Do not get involved or investigate yourself. Report it...and let law enforcement deal with it. Remember, the situation may be dangerous, absolutely no confrontations.

Law Enforcement is only as good as the information...and cooperation...it receives from the public. You are our most important link to your community. Help us help you.

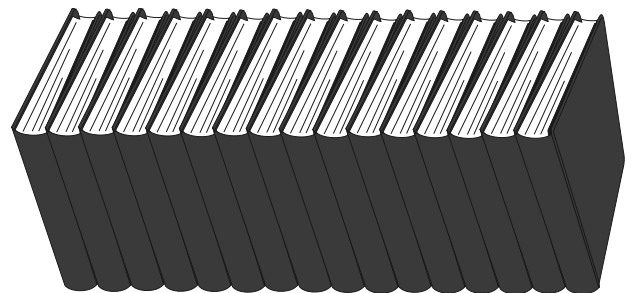

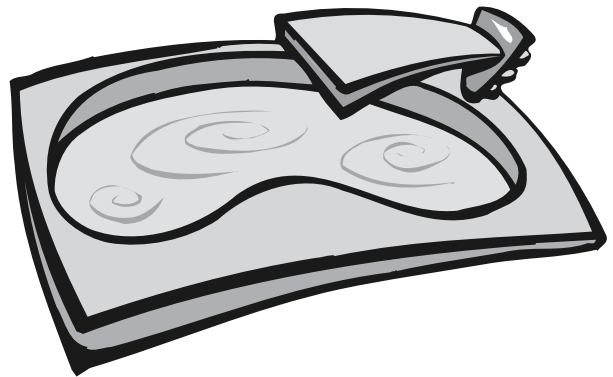

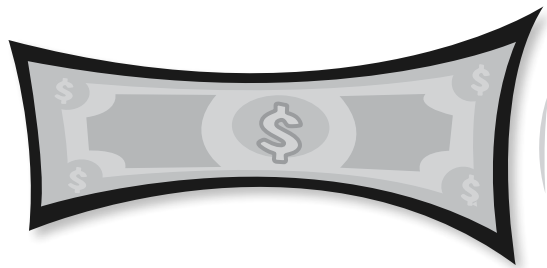

Recently a concern was expressed to the Town Center Manager about Mopeds on the lake walks. Mopeds fit the definition of a motor vehicle in 322.01(26) Florida Statutes, and s. 322.03, F.S. requires a driver license to operate any motor vehicle. Mopeds may not be operated on bicycle paths or footpaths when operated using a motor according to Florida law.

The VeronaWalk Safety Committee met and composed a 'Rule' to clarify what devices/vehicles are allowed over the bridges and walkways in the VeronaWalk Community. The rule was presented to the Board of Directors and was accepted, signed and put into the official records on June 9, 2008

The following is the Rule:

Community Bridges and Walkways

The only devices/vehicles allowed over the bridges and the walkways leading to bridges are:

- Golf carts.
- Wheel chairs (motorized and non motorized), and similar devices required for medical conditions.
- Bicycles (non motorized/propelled).
- Skateboards and similar devices without any means of propulsion (i.e.: gasoline, electric motors etc.).
- Roller skates.
- Baby carriages/strollers.

At no time shall motorcycles, motor scooters with seats, mopeds, and all terrain vehicles, etc. be allowed on bridges and walkways in VeronaWalk.

All devices shall be used in a manner as not to create a nuisance to others. Non-compliance, or abuse will lead to loss of privileges.

Resident Bar Code Notification

If you do not have a Valid Bar Code corresponding to home ownership, are not an authorized tenant with a current lease on file with Southwest Property Management, or do not have a lease renewal on file with the Town Manager's Office, your bar codes will be turned off.
