Hurricane Season!

Florida's Hurricane season begins June 1 and continues until November 30. August and September are the busiest months, both in the number of tropical disturbances and in the intensity of the storms.

Here are some key phrases you may hear on the news:

Tropical Storm Watch: An announcement is made for specific coastal areas where tropical storm conditions pose a possible threat within 36 hours.

Tropical Storm Warning: A warning that tropical storm conditions, including possible sustained winds of 39-73 mph, are expected in specific coastal areas within 24 hours.

Hurricane Watch: An announcement that indicates a hurricane is near enough that everyone in the area should listen for subsequent advisories and be ready to take precautionary measures. Watches are usually 24-36 hours in advance of landfall.

Hurricane Warning: A warning that sustained winds of 74 mph or greater associated with a hurricane are expected in 24 hours or less. All precautions should be taken immediately.

Hurricanes are classified by Categories:

Category	Wind Speed	Storm Surge	Damage
1	74-95 mph	4-5 Feet	Minimal
2	96-110 mph	6-8 Feet	Moderate
3	111-130 mph	9-12 Feet	Extensive
4	131-155 mph	13-18 Feet	Extreme
5	155 Plus	18 Feet Plus	Catastrophic

72- hour disaster survival kit:

To prepare for the unknown, your home should have a 72-hour disaster survival kit. You will need to pack some essential items to help you and your family survive, whether you stay at home or leave during a disaster. Keep in mind that during a major power outage, ATM machines will be inoperable. Be sure to have cash on hand in case you must evacuate the area.
