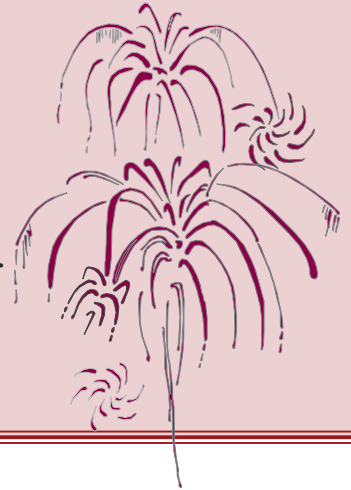

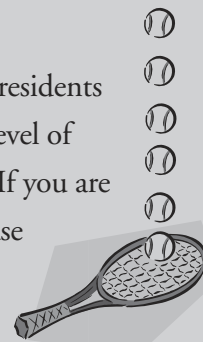

NORDIC POLE WALKING!

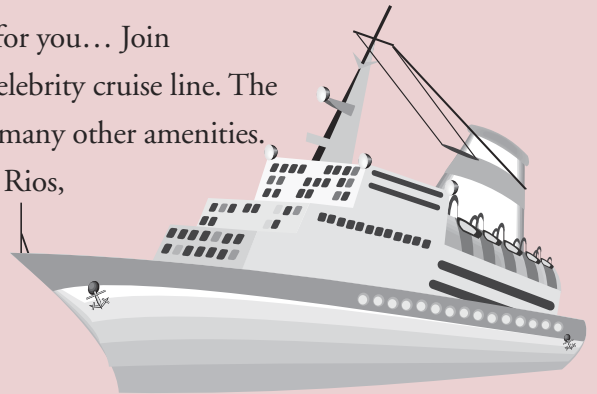

MAILBOXES

ALLIGATORS

If you see an alligator in one of our lakes and would like to report it to the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, please call 305-289-2323. We ask that you please use the following guidelines.

- The FF&W will not remove an alligator simply because it is in a lake or sunning itself on a bank. An alligator must be acting in an aggressive manner for FF&W to be contacted.
- FF&W will not accept second-hand information; they need to speak with the person who sights the alligator.
- When calling, please advise the agent of the approximate length of the alligator and the exact location.



HOA INFORMATION

PICK UP TRUCK PARKING

This remains our number one problem within the community and the one we will be placing the most focus on in the upcoming months. We have renewed our efforts to resolve parking issues by working with all residents. Please review the following guidelines on parking:

- a) Pick-up trucks belonging to residents or their guests must be parked in the garage with the door closed. No truck owned by a resident (Owner or Tenant) is allowed to be parked on the street or in the driveway.

Please help us eliminate this violation to our community's governing documents.

TIP OF THE MONTH

GARBAGE CONTAINERS

1. Collier County makes two garbage pick-ups each week. The first pick-up is every Monday and is for regular household garbage only. The second pick-up is every Thursday and is for regular household garbage and for recyclable materials. The Garbage Containers are to be set at the end of the driveway on the driveway pavers that are adjacent to the street. The containers may be set out after 6:00 PM the night before the scheduled pick-up day. The containers are to be taken back in no later than 6:00 PM the day of the scheduled pick-up.
2. Garbage Containers are not to be left outside after 6:00 PM of the scheduled pick-up day. The containers must be stored inside the garage with the garage door closed.

PETS

Community Rules and Collier County Ordinances require all pets to be on a leash and the pet owner present whenever a pet is outdoors.

Owners are also required to properly pick-up and dispose of any animal waste.



Please have the courtesy to pick up after your pet when walking within the community. Taking a moment of your

time to pick up after your pet will go a long way to maintaining a healthy environment for all persons in Verona Walk.

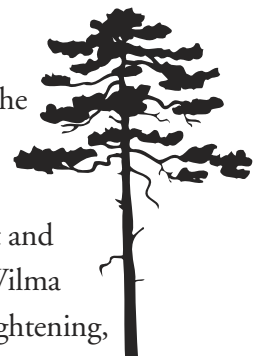


PLEASE NOTE:

LANDSCAPING ISSUES

1. Trees - During the next several weeks we will be working with the landscape maintenance contractor trim, straighten and re-stake all of the trees that are at risk in the upcoming hurricane season. Several of trees that were reset and staked following Hurricane Wilma are in need of additional straightening, re-staking and replacement.
2. Lawn Maintenance - As we enter the rainy season, the schedule for mowing and edging was reset to weekly service effective June 15th.
