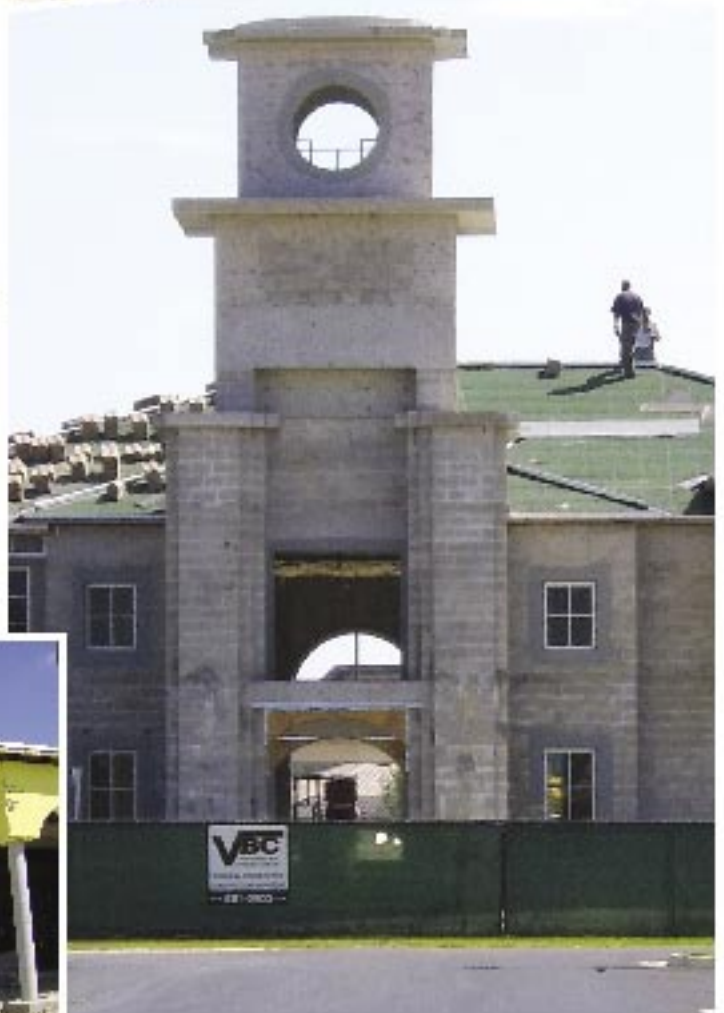

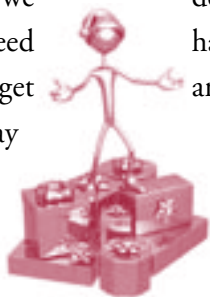

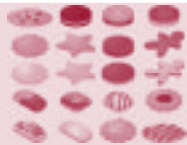

## ARCHITECTURAL CONTROL

Any change to the exterior of your home including but not limited to: plants, flower pots, satellite dishes, hanging decorations, statues, yard decorations, generators, sauna, spa, pool, windsocks, solar lighting, attachments and the like must be submitted to the Architectural Control Committee (ACC) prior to installation. The forms are located in the Town Center Manager's office in the Capri Model. All applications must be submitted the Tuesday prior to the third Thursday of each month for consideration. All applicable brochures, pictures, drawings, construction plans and/or specifications. There is a damage deposit fee of \$500.00 required to protect the repair to the common area should any occur. If in doubt contact the Town Center Manager's office before making any enhancements. Under no circumstances is artificial vegetation permitted on any portion of the exterior of your home.

No approval shall be necessary to display one U.S. flag attached by a dowel not larger than one (1) inch in diameter which is wall mounted adjacent to the garage door of a unit.

## LANDSCAPE / IRRIGATION

We had a significantly rainy summer and now we have abruptly begun the dry season. While we did turn off the irrigation for the majority of the months of August and September, we are now turning the irrigation back on, you will see the lake levels drop and possibly some areas that are not getting an abundance of water. Keep in mind that the irrigation system operates only on days as permissible as established by the water conservation plan of Collier County.

You may contact us at 774-0026 to report irrigation issues. Rest assured the irrigation contractor has representatives within the community five (5) days weekly performing checks and maintenance.

**NO GARAGE MAY BE USED AS A LIVING AREA - NO GARAGE DOORS SHALL BE PERMITTED TO REMAIN OPEN EXCEPT FOR TEMPORARY SERVICES.**

## LAKE MAINTENANCE

The Association contracts with a firm to maintain the lakes and the vegetation in the lakes. The invasion vegetation is treated and killed which will cause a grassy-like substance to float on the sides or banks of the lakes. This algae is then treated at a later time with a copper chemical that causes a green hue of the water in the lake. This will eventually dissipate. The Lake Maintenance is performed monthly or more depending upon the need.

## BUDGET



It is the time of year that the Board of Directors and the Management Team are working on the operational budget numbers for 2007. The adopted 2007 budget will be mailed to each Owner in December along with the first Quarter coupons. Your maintenance fees are due on the first day of January, April, July & October. There will be increases in cable and other standard cost of living increases so we do anticipate an increase in the quarterly maintenance fees.
