REPORT A CRIME. YOU CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE

Nationwide, it was determined that the number of arrests for criminal activity would double...if only crime were reported immediately. Locally, three out of every four arrests can be related to a call from a citizen.

You, as citizens of our County, have a tremendous effect on the ability of law enforcement to successfully bring a case to conclusion. Here are some things to remember about reporting crimes.

Report suspected criminal activity immediately...do not wait. The sooner law enforcement can respond, the more likely they are to apprehend someone.

Be as accurate in the description of people and vehicles as you can. If they have left the area before we arrive, your observations will be the only information with which we have to work.

If you are not sure something is wrong, report it to law enforcement anyway. It is better we check it and find nothing wrong, than allow someone to be needlessly victimized.

Do not get involved or investigate yourself. Report it...and let law enforcement deal with it. Remember, the situation may be dangerous.

Law Enforcement is only as good as the information...and cooperation...it receives from the public. You are our most important link to your community. Help us help you.

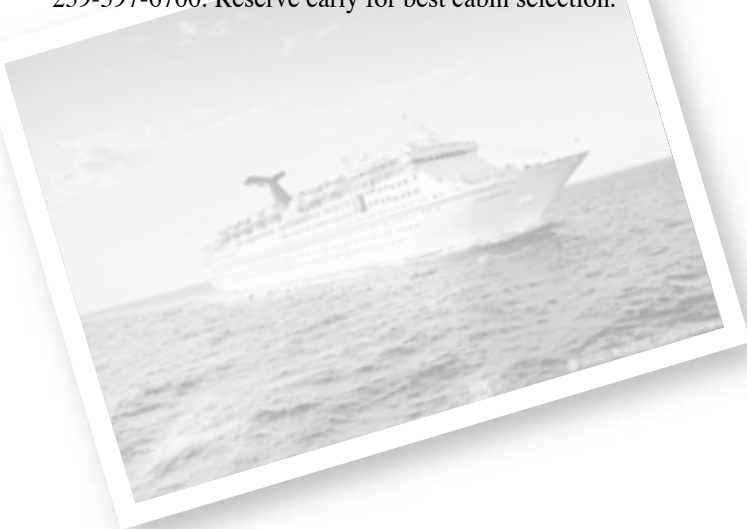

If you think your children may be in these photos feel free to stop by the HOA office to view them. We have repeatedly had bicycles on the Bocce and Tennis Courts. The Courts are not made for this type of activity. We have had to repair tennis maintenance equipment because children are using the equipment as play things and are abusive. There have been teenagers on the tot lot. The tot lot is an age appropriate area and children over eight years of age do not belong in the area for smaller children and toddlers. The damages that occur and the subsequent repairs will get into each and every owner's pocketbook because fees could be affected if things get out of control.

In the interim, your trash cans shall not be visible from a neighboring home, common area or the street. Place them in the garage.

RUST

Many of you may have noticed that there are rust stains on the sidewalks and or homes in the community. Our irrigation system irrigates from the lakes and often times there is a large quantity of iron in the lakes thus creating these stains. In an effort to prevent this you may notice "flotation" devices in the lakes keeping the intake lines off of the bottom. If rust stains still occur you can buy over-the-counter rust removal products from any home improvement store or online. We will soon begin rust removal in the common areas.
